**CURRENT POSITION:** Associate Professor at the Department of Veterinary Medical Sciences (Academic discipline: VET/08 Veterinary Clinical Medicine). Born in Casoli – Italy (18/06/1964). Member of the National Committee for the protection of animals used for scientific purposes, Ministry of Health. Chair of the Animal Welfare Body of the University of Bologna (2015 – to present). Director of the Service for the welfare of the animals used for scientific and educational purposes of the University of Bologna. Member of the Ethics Committee for the protection of animals used for experimental purposes of Emilia Romagna Region. Member of the Ethics Committee of the Istituto Zooprofilattico Sperimentale della Lombardia e dell'Emilia Romagna. President of the Ethics Committee of the ANMVI. Since 1999 the teaching activities, at undergraduate as well as post graduate levels degree, are focused on animal welfare and legislation.

The research activities are focused on:

1. Legal medicine and veterinary legislation with particular regard on animal welfare, animal health and the crimes against the animals;
2. Assessment of animal welfare: the heat stress in dairy cows and beef cattle; the evaluation immunity response during spontaneous and experimentally induced diseases in farm and laboratory animals; the evaluation of indicators involved in passive immunity in calf, lamb and foal; the methods to estimate the age of puppies and tail docking in sheep;
3. Bioethics: issues regarding the use of animal for scientific and educational purposes;
4. Other research activities are based on clinical activity in companion and farm animal species.
