## NESTLÉ PURINA VETERINARY RESIDENT RESEARCH GRANT PROGRAM

The objective of this program is to facilitate the advancement of knowledge in canine and feline nutrition and health care, as well as supporting the professional development of residents-in-training at veterinary institutions. Towards this end, a fund has been established that will provide small grants (up to \$15,000) to support well-designed research addressing nutritional issues relative to the dog and cat. Invasive or terminal research will not be considered for funding. Only veterinarians enrolled in a recognized residency or graduate degree program, or their mentor on behalf of the resident or graduate student, are eligible to apply for these funds. Grants will be awarded on a competitive basis. Selection will be based on review of research proposals received on, or prior to, the published deadlines. Research proposals will be accepted twice yearly, on or before May 1 and on or before November 1 of each year. To apply, veterinary residents must submit the materials itemized below.

### The application packet should include the following:

1. Cover letter describing the intent of the research, the expected new findings likely to come from this research, and the significance of these findings should the research be successful.
2. Research proposal, limited to 5 typed pages, but must include the following sections:
  - a. Research hypothesis or objective
  - b. Review of the pertinent literature and prior research
  - c. Experimental Design, including anticipated statistical analysis and timing to completion of the project
  - d. Budget, detailing all key expenses. Indirect costs, if included, must be limited to 25% of direct cost less any salary and equipment.
3. Evidence of approval from your institutional Animal Care and Use Committee
4. Evidence of adequacy of skills, equipment, and other resources needed to complete the proposed research. If collaborations are necessary, include letters that confirm the collaborators' agreement to participate.
